## CHIEF INSTRUCTOR'S REPORT

This season proved to be very successful in terms of awards gained after a shaky start. The Club ended up with 51 awards which is a top effort for those involved.

Once again a meeting of new and existing Club Members interested in gaining an award was held. This resulted in the forming of two Bronze Squads and a Surf Life Saving Certificate Squad. Once training began, the squads grew in numbers and those ready to complete their awards did so.

The time and effort put in by the Instructors this season should not go unnoticed. This season many of the candidates for BM and SLSC were new to life saving and it was not only a matter of preparing them for the exam but also teaching them how to negotiate the surf, how to paddle a board, surf awareness, about the Surf Club in general and resuscitation techniques. Thank you Steve Connor, Bill Haran, Peter McDonald, Des O'Brien and Peter Turner for training these squads.

The Club lacked a District Supervisor this season which may have slowed the progress of awards. Without a District Supervisor the members lacked someone from outside the Club to offer advice, solve problems and provide much needed encouragement. It was then necessary to call on Club members to examine the BM Part A and SLSC. Filling these roles were Evan Griffiths and Don Harris. Special thanks to Lance Strickland, the Northern Zone Exam Co-ordinator, for his work in examining the Bronze Awards and IRB awards this season.

A very successful Proficiency Test program was run by this Club this season that resulted in 107 Proficient members. This number

would be the most for the Club in recent years. The members should be congratulated for their enthusiastic participation in the Proficiency Test. This year's Proficiency Test included for the first time an IRB component. This was not widely accepted at first but many of the members found that the IRB is more fun than it looks once they got in it and had a go.
