

Helensburgh Workmens Club Ltd

Our major supporter continues to be the Helensburgh Workmens Club Ltd, with the President of that Club again accepting the honour of being Patron of the Surf Club.

My thanks goes to Club Captain Mark Thompson and the patrolling members for a very hard job; well done.

There were some fine efforts at carnivals during the season with Simon Harris successfully defending his Open Beach Flags title at the State Championships and almost "icing the cake" with a Silver at the Aussies, leaving no doubt that he has shown his knockers that he now is a true champion.

Besides Simon there was a general good showing from the beach team with Matt Potter and Andrew Astill in good form all season.

For the first time in many years, we had some enthusiastic water competitors with Paul Bedwell, Daniel Thompson and Alicia McCormack, Paul putting in some great efforts during the season. Let me take this chance to thank Kev Morton for his work training our water competitors.

Unfortunately our boat fraternity suffered a down turn in numbers with our Vets crew having a year off and some members leaving for other clubs. Thank you to Mark Wallace for his continued enthusiasm and to those who did row for showing the Club colours in the boat arena.

Fund raising this year was quite successful with the Registered Clubs Association car raffle, lifesavers appeal day and a Christmas raffle, plus the annual Two-up Day at the Workmens Club with enough members helping out to raise over \$500.00.



To Jan's family and other families who have lost loved ones during the year, the Club and members extend their sincere condolences




Patrol Membership

- 117 proficient Bronze Medallion holders.
- 24 Under 16 Cadet members undertaking patrols, 14 male and 10 female.
- · 23 Cadet members proficient
- 13 Patrols each with an average of 8 Bronze Medallion holders and a minimum of one IRB Driver and one ARC holder
- 60 members (48%) recorded 100% patrol attendance

Minimum Patrol strengths as set by Surf Life Saving Illawarra were achieved on all patrols, and exceeded on all but six patrols.

- September, October and November, and March and April
 - 3 Bronze holders on Sundays and public holidays (2 x 4 hour patrols).
- December, January and February
 - 4 Bronze holders on Sundays and public holidays (2 x 4 hour patrols).
- Saturday patrols (4 hours) December, January and February with 3 Bronze holders.
- Minimum one proficient IRB Driver on each patrol.

INSTRUCTION & TRAINING

A great season in terms of awards and one of the strongest for a long time with 25 Bronze Medallions, but disappointingly no new IRB Drivers.

This season saw the release of the 31st Edition of the Surf Life Saving Training Manual. The manual has been restructured to conform with competency-based training methods. It is broken up into units consisting of Surf Awareness, Emergency Care, Basic First Aid. Senior First Aid. Resuscitation. Resuscitation (CPR). Advanced Resuscitation, Radio Operations, Surf Skills, Rescue Techniques, IRB Crewing, Carries and Supports, and Patrols. Awards cover a few of many of the units listed.

Our statistics as shown in the graph shows an increase in the number of awards over the previous season, and an average of 43 awards each season for the last five years. Any increase in the number of awards gained is a step towards the continued growth of our Club.

Bronze Medallion and Surf Rescue Certificate.

The Surf Life saving Certificate or the old Qualifying Certificate has a new name, the Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC). The SRC is the introduction to surf life saving for members not old enough to do their Bronze Medallion and consists of Surf Awareness, Basic Resuscitation, Rescue Techniques, Emergency Care, Surf Skills and Patrols.

The Bronze Medallion remains the same with the traditional Run-Swim-Run the focus of the award. The BM also includes Surf Awareness, Basic Resuscitation, Rescue Techniques, Radio Operations, Resuscitation (CPR), IRB Crewing, Emergency Care, Surf Skills, Patrols, Basic First Aid and Carries and Support.

25 Bronze Medallions were gained by Club members, seven of these by members new to the Club. 17 were gained by members who have come up through the Juniors and one Associate member who decided it was time to take the plunge.

It was a good season for instructors with 12 members taking up the challenge to train fellow members for their awards. The instructors were Steve Connor, Bill Haran, Peter McDonald, Steven McDonald, Peter O'Halloran, Nicole Osburne, Paul Potter, Tanya Potter, Geoff Ryder, Steve Shorten, Peter Turner and Daryl Turnbull.

Congratulations to all members who gained their BM or SRC. Thank you to all instructors who put aside one afternoon and a Sunday morning each week to train their fellow Club members.

Advanced Resuscitation Certificate

The ARC underwent a major change this season, the age at which you can train for the award was lowered to 15 years and First Aid was dropped. The removal of the First Aid component is with the view to more members gaining their First Aid Certificate. The ARC now consists of Basic Resuscitation, Resuscitation (CPR) and Advanced Resuscitation.

This season nine members gained the award, six under the old structure and three under the new structure.

ARC Instructors this season were Peter McDonald, Steven McDonald, Peter O'Halloran and Andrew Taylor.

Inshore Rescue Boat Drivers Certificate

Unfortunately another season has passed without any new IRB Drivers. Since 1989 the Club has trained only 19 new IRB drivers not a good record. Some off-season initiatives to boost driver number are being trialled including intense training over a long weekend and follow up training.

IRB Crewperson Certificate has returned. This award is available to members over the age of 14 years and will also be offered along with the IRB Drivers award.

Proficiency Tests

Bronze Medallion/Surf Rescue Certificate
The season ended with 140 proficient
members, 117 Bronze Medallion holders and

23 Surf Rescue Certificate holders, a drop on last seasons numbers.

The Proficiency Test consisted of the traditional Run-Swim-run, One person assessment Tube/Board/IRB Rescues and Signal and Surf Awareness questions.

Thanks to Peter Beehag, Evan Griffiths, Jeff Lucke, Bobo White and Dave Winner for running two trouble free Proficiency Tests.

Advanced Resuscitation Certificate

22 members renewed their ARC, resulting in a total of 31 proficient ARC holders for the season.

The ARC refresher training is proving to be very successful with all proficient members attending at lease one training session before the test.

IRB Drivers Certificate

Only 16 Drivers renewed their IRBD this season, this being down on last years number of 24, possibly an indication of the Club's current problem with IRB Drivers.

Two proficiency days were organised for early October and December. Thanks to Warren Herrmann and Anthony Turner from Surf Life Saving Illawarra for coming up and running the tests.



Committee Meetings

Management Committee meetings were scheduled and held monthly commencing August through to May. A meeting was not held in June.

Management Committee meetings required nine Committee members to form a quorum; this was only achieved at three of the ten meetings held, with average attendance 7.5 members at meetings over the year. Whilst three members were regularly unable to attend meetings because of work commitments and submitted their apologies, there were regrettably four members who appeared to have no interest in attending Committee meetings.

The Executive Committee met formally on three occasions. Matters discussed at these meetings were reported at subsequent meetings of the Management Committee.

The Junior Activities Committee met monthly with Junior Activities delegates reporting regularly to the Management Committee.

The Club House Committee met twice, firstly to deal with cleaning of the main hall and amenities and possible extensions, and a second meeting to consider proposals submitted by members for such extensions.

The Executive Committee convened one meeting with competitors to discuss funding for touring teams and accommodation and carnival entries generally. The agreed arrangements were not implemented during the season and carnival entries and entry fees, and accommodation arrangements for touring teams are still unresolved issues for the Management Committee to address.

The Social Committee met as required to plan specific functions.

Incorporation requirements

The Annual Statement as required under the Associations Incorporation Act, 1984 was submitted to the Department of Fair Trading for the 1997/98 year following the last Annual General Meeting.

Affiliation with Surf Life Saving, Australia

As approved at the last Annual General Meeting, the Club applied for continuing affiliation with Surf Life Saving Australia.

Liquor Licence

The Club has continued to maintain a Function Licence to enable the sale of alcohol for consumption within the Club premises. The Licence is held by the Club Secretary, Harley Dreghorn.

Membership Registration

Membership forms were again pre-printed based on information provided by members in the previous season. A computerised database containing extensive details on all current members continues to be maintained and is able to provide statistical and historical information about the Club and its members. The database continues to be managed by Registrar Steven McDonald.

Outstanding amounts due from members

The Club continues to experience difficulties collecting Club fees and other amounts payable by members. This includes amounts that have been paid on behalf of Club members for accommodation, tickets, tee shirts, etc and regrettably requires Club officers to spend unnecessary time following up these payments.

At the end of the financial year, membership fees were outstanding from 38 members, 21 of whom were patrolling members. Three members had not paid for accommodation occupied at the Australian Championships six weeks earlier, whilst there were other amounts unpaid for tee shirts supplied.

The Management Committee is pursuing these outstanding amounts.

Notices to Members

The Park Bench was issued monthly between August and June, with the Publicity Officer Christine McDonald taking over responsibility for preparation and issue from September. The Park Bench was used as a medium to convey official notices to Club members, or such notices were included as inserts.

Asset Register

The documentation and valuation of all Club equipment was progressed, but had not been finalised at the end of the year.

Club House

Cleaning of the Club house continues to be a major issue although thanks to a few volunteer members, cleaning is being carried out on an ad hoc basis and the main hall and amenities are maintained in a reasonable condition

During the year, members were invited to submit ideas for extension of the Surf Club.

Four members submitted suggestions ranging from minor internal changes, to a major extension at the western end with additional boat shed storage, training room and verandah/deck along the southern facade

The Club House Committee now needs to meet with Council officers to determine the criteria and restrictions on possible extensions before recommending a master plan to Club members for approval.

Towards the end of the year a formal request was made to Wollongong Council to consider a joint scheme to extend the boat shed at the western end as the first stage of an extension that will allow Council lifeguards to place their equipment within the Club building, and enable removal of the Council container.

At the same time, the Management Committee has agreed on disposal of the Club's storage container and through minor re-organisation the placement of all Junior Activities equipment within the boat shed.

Half of the profit raised from refreshment sales will again be allocated to a special Building Account fund. At the end of the year, with transfer of a further \$2,800.00

representing half of this seasons bar profit, the fund stood at \$11,000.00.

The Surf Club was hired out for a small number of private functions during the year with a return of around \$500.00. However the effort and input required by Club members to liase with potential hirers, arranging their special requirements, cleaning, setting up, and generally ensuring their expectations are met is very time consuming for a small financial return and hire outs are not actively encouraged.

If this activity is to be continued, then a person prepared to take on the role of hall manager is required, as well as more regular cleaning.

Youth Development

During the year, Surf Life Saving Illawarra organised a Youth Forum. Our Club was represented by Andrew Astill, Christopher Ryder and Michelle Ryder, with Evan Griffiths attending as one of the facilitators.

Our younger members reported back that the day consisted of casual questions and exchange of ideas and they enjoyed being involved.

Subsequently Branch officers prepared a report including the recommendations arising from the day, and these were discussed at a Branch meeting; recommendations include social functions for younger members, competition for younger members, promotion of lifesaving and the formation of a Youth Advisory Committee made up of representatives of all Illawarra clubs. It is also intended the forum become an annual event.

It is now up to our Club's committee and younger members to implement the proposals within our Club.

Credits

During the year, the Club's standing in the local community and Surf Life Saving generally has been enhanced by some of our members.

At the end of last season, Evan Griffiths was awarded with Life Membership of Surf Life Saving, Illawarra, an award well deserved by Evan given the countless time he has put into Junior Activities, junior and senior carnivals, and as District Supervisor for this area

Evan later became one of the first Helensburgh people to be awarded with a Community Service Award by the Federal Member for Hughes, Mrs Dana Vale, MP; Evan's citation read "..that he is a life member of the Helensburgh-Stanwell Park Surf Life Saving Club, and has been involved with lifesaving for 31 years. As well he has served as an honorary auditor to 12 organisations."

Bob Proudfoot, a member of our Club for many years, President of Helensburgh Workmens Club and Patron of the Surf Club was also honoured for his contribution to sporting organisations and establishment of a youth centre at Helensburgh.

Nathan Johnston, a Junior member of the Club became an overnight star in his own right as he explained to the Sunday Telegraph, Illawarra Mercury and WIN TV how he enjoyed being a member of the Club, about his activities within the Club and the Sea Eels and the help given by his parents.

Thank you Nathan for the kind words you had to say of your involvement in the Club.

Our Club was mentioned on National TV during the telecast of the finals of the Australian Championships, with Simon Harris coming from a club that does not get a mention much at the Australian Championships. A few minutes later the announcer referred to "...Helensburgh — Stanwell Park as a Club most people would probably never have heard of."

At the Branch Presentation Night, our Club was honoured with the selection of Steven McDonald as 1999 Illawarra Branch Volunteer of the Year; this is Steve's second major Branch award having won the Illawarra Branch Lifesaver of the Year award in 1991.

Congratulations Steve, and also congratulations to Mark Thompson on reaching the final 5 in the Branch Lifesaver of the Year and Ron McCormack the final 5 in the Branch Junior Activities Volunteer of the Year.

Representation at Branch, State and Australian level of Surf Life Saving

At Branch level, Bobo White held the position of Competition Director, Jeff Lucke, Board of Junior Activities Superintendent, and Evan Griffiths, District Supervisor for our Club

Don Harris was the convenor of the Life Saver of the Year Committee.

In addition a number of Club members are active members of the Board of Life Saving Control, and/or involved as judges at carnivals within the Illawarra Branch.

Don Harris was a member of the NSW Surf Boat Premiership Panel, and together with Bobo White and Jeff Lucke, held senior judging positions at State and Australian championship events.

Curry. A meeting was organised for 10.00am Sunday 9 April, 1989, from that time on it is now all history.

Foundation members still active within the winter swimming group are Keith Newell, Robert Pugh, Rick Dzopalic, Steven and Peter McDonald, John Murphy, Bobo White, Peter and Don Burke, Graham McCrae, Mark Wallace and Harley Dreghorn.

Since then we have transformed the Surf Club from being a closed shop during the winter season, to an open house for the 20 weeks of winter swimming. The till has been turning over in favour of the Surf Club and numerous charitable donations have been made to many organisations and worthy individuals. There are no balances or statistics, the donations were made with the full support and blessings of the members and from a personal point of view, I have never been associated with a more generous and good-hearted group of people.

Possibly our biggest donation, not only in monetary terms, has been the conducting of the regular visits by the handicapped children and young adults from the Baringa Centre at Fairy Meadow over six years.
