




chief instructors report

training and awards

A good solid season for the core Surf Life Saving Awards, ensuring that the club maintains good patrol strength throughout the coming seasons. 39 awards were gained by club members, including 21 Bronze Medallions, 8 Surf Rescue Certificates, 4 Inflatable Rescue Boat Drivers and 6 Inflatable Rescue Boat Crew Certificates. The only notable absence in the usual awards gained by club members is the Advanced Resuscitation Certificate.

There were no changes to the Training Manual used for training this season. The promised IRB Training Manual did not eventuate from Surf Life Saving Australia, hopefully it will be ready for next season.

The graph indicates the second season of declining award numbers and a below average number of awards overall, but an above average number of Bronze Medallions. The lack of ARC's and other awards such as Radio Operators Certificates and Training Officer has contributed to the fall in award numbers.



bronze medallion + surf rescue certificate

The Bronze Medallion syllabus as per the training manual includes Surf Awareness, Emergency Care, Basic First Aid, Basic Resuscitation, Resuscitation (CPR), Radio Operations, Surf Skills, Rescue Techniques, IRB Crewing, Carries & Supports and Patrols. The Surf Rescue Certificate syllabus includes Surf Awareness, Emergency Care, Basic Resuscitation, Surf Skills, Rescue Techniques, Carries & Supports and Patrols. This has not varied since last season.

New members bolstered the number of Bronze Medallions gained this season and most of these new members were over 18 years of age. It is good to see parents of our junior members becoming active in the club. The new members represented approximately 50% of the successful candidates; the remainder of the candidates have come through the juniors up into the senior club.

A slight drop off in the number of Surf Rescue Certificates due to a fewer number of juniors coming through, but this is a cyclic occurrence so the club can expect growth in Surf Rescue Certificates over the next few seasons.

Instructors came out of the woodwork this season enabling each squad to be assigned at least two instructors. Some of the instructors were old hands and some were new to the game. In all, the club had a dedicated group people working towards gaining Bronze Medallions and Surf Rescue Certificates for the club. Thanks go to Mark Wallace, Steve Connor, Daryl Turnbull, Geoff Ryder, Peter Turner, Peter McDonald, Steven McDonald, Peter O'Halloran, Ray Buchan and Shanus Lane, they put in many hours working with the candidates on all aspects of their awards.

Congratulations to all club members who gained their BM and SRC, and thank you to all club instructors who put aside one afternoon and a Sunday morning each week to train their fellow club members.

advanced resuscitation certificate

There were no Advanced Resuscitation Certificates gained by club members this season. There will be some work done to rectify this before the start of the next season.

IRB drivers + crewperson certificate

IRB Driver numbers are improving in the club again with 4 new drivers this season and 6 IRB Crewpersons. The addition of these 4 drivers brings our number of active IRB Drivers in the club to 22, allowing for at least 2 drivers per patrol for next season.

Along with the 4 drivers that gained their awards during the season about 9 other members started training at some time in the season, hopefully with the right amount of encouragement these members will finish the training and gain their award.

The IRB Driver Certificate takes about 2 months to complete with a few solid weekends of driving to gain skills and experience (rollover procedures), the real learning starts when you get your award and start driving on patrol. The IRB Driver Certificate involves crewing, patient pickups, motor maintenance, and driving. The promised release of a new IRB Training Manual for next season should see some improved training techniques introduced and make the theory more enjoyable.

I encourage all members who have just completed their Surf Rescue Certificate to think about training for their Crewperson Certificate during next season, it is a matter of spending time in the IRB and learning patient pickup techniques and general IRB operations. The award is a great step towards gaining your IRB Driver Certificate.

Thanks to the IRB Captain Graham Cook, Paul Potter and Mark Ryan for training up our new drivers and crewpersons this season.

proficiency tests

bronze medallion + surf rescue certificate

A solid season for Bronze Medallion and Surf Rescue Certificate Proficiencies with 117 members being proficient by the end of the season. The 117 were made up of 99 Bronze Medallion and 18 Surf Rescue Certificate. These numbers represent a small drop on last season, but we are still putting more than 110 patrol members on the beach.

The proficiency test this season included the Run-Swim-Run, One and Two-Person Assessment, Tube/Board/IRB Rescues, Signals and Surf Awareness.

Even Griffiths did an excellent job this season as District Supervisor, he turned up at just about every patrol early in the season to run patrol members through resuscitation section of the proficiency. Thanks also to all the club examiners and instructors who helped out on the two proficiency days.

advance resuscitation certificate

A repeat of last seasons outstanding success with ARC proficiencies with 44 members submitting themselves for the test.

As with the Bronze Medallion and Surf Rescue Certificate Proficiency, Evan Griffiths contribution was invaluable. Evan tested most of the members in conjunction with the BM/SRC resuscitation testing, this cut down on the amount of time required for training and testing. Because of Evan's involvement in the proficiency testing there was no ARC Refresher Training held this season.

IRB driver certificate

Once again all club's IRB Drivers renewed their proficiency this season, 22 drivers in total. The test days were held in conjunction with the BM/SRC Proficiency days.

conclusion

With no ARC awards done this season, there will be a push next year to catch-up with all those members who would have done this award during the season. Also any members wishing to do other awards the club has to offer, like Radio Operators Certificate, Gold Medallion, Training Officer, or even a Resuscitation Certificate should give this some thought in readiness for next season.

Thanks to all members who have contributed in any of the training for their fellow clubs members throughout the season and congratulations to all members that gained an award during the season.

secretary's report

committee meetings

Management Committee meetings were scheduled and held monthly throughout the season, with the exception of the month of July. All meetings were conducted at the Helensburgh Workmen's Club and were regularly attended by the committee members.

The Junior Activities Committee also met monthly at the Helensburgh Workmen's Club, with the Junior Activities delegates reporting regularly to the Management Committee.

The Stanwell Park Sea Eels Winter Swimming Club conducted unscheduled meetings, also at the Helensburgh Workmen's Club and matters discussed were reported to the Management Committee.

statutory requirements

The Annual Statement as required under the Associations Incorporation Act, 1984 was submitted to the Department of Fair Trading for the 1999-2000 year.

The Registrar of the Australian Business Register and Commissioner of Taxation issued the Club with an Australian Business Number (ABN) 92 267 821 862 and was effective from the 01 July 2001. Harley Dreghorn being the Public Officer.

State Government introduced the "Working With Children Check" under The Child Protection (Prohibited Employment) Act 1998 and the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998, an important initiative for checking paid and unpaid employees, such as volunteers, working with children and young people under the age of eighteen. Evan Griffiths was appointed Child Protection Officer for the Illawarra Branch and Debra McCormack for our Club. All members who assist with this age group are required to sign a Prohibited Employment Declaration Form.

affiliation with surf life saving australia

As approved at the last Annual General Meeting, the Club applied for continuing affiliation with Surf Life Saving Australia.

asset register

The documentation and valuation of all Club equipment has been updated, but valuation of most assets still requires finalisation.

liquor licence

The Club continues to maintain a Function Licence for the sale of alcohol for consumption within the Club premises, with the licence held by Harley Dreghorn.

membership registration

A computerised database containing extensive details on all current members continues to be maintained and updated by the Club Registrar, Steven McDonald. The database can generate statistical and historical information about the Club and its members. The recording of member information in this format provides enormous benefits to the Club and is far in advance of membership recording provided by other Surf Life Saving bodies.

Membership forms are pre-printed containing information provided by members the previous season. Upgrading of membership is minimal with only medical and minor changes to be noted.

The database can be used to inform members of required proficiency's, future awards, financial status and Club history. It also provides a current mailing list and is currently being upgraded with past members information as far back as records allows. Other 10, 15 and 20 year Patrol Service Awards along with 25 and 50 Membership Awards are currently being investigated. At the end of the financial year, only 6 out of 397 member's fees remained outstanding.

communicating with members

The monthly circulation of the Park Bench, along with notices included as inserts, remains as our best form of communication with Club members. Our Publicity Officer Christine McDonald prepares the Park Bench from information provided by Club members and organises the monthly distribution.

Feedback from members is very positive and the introduction of sponsors for the Park Bench this season, has alleviated the cost of circulation to 250 individuals and families.
